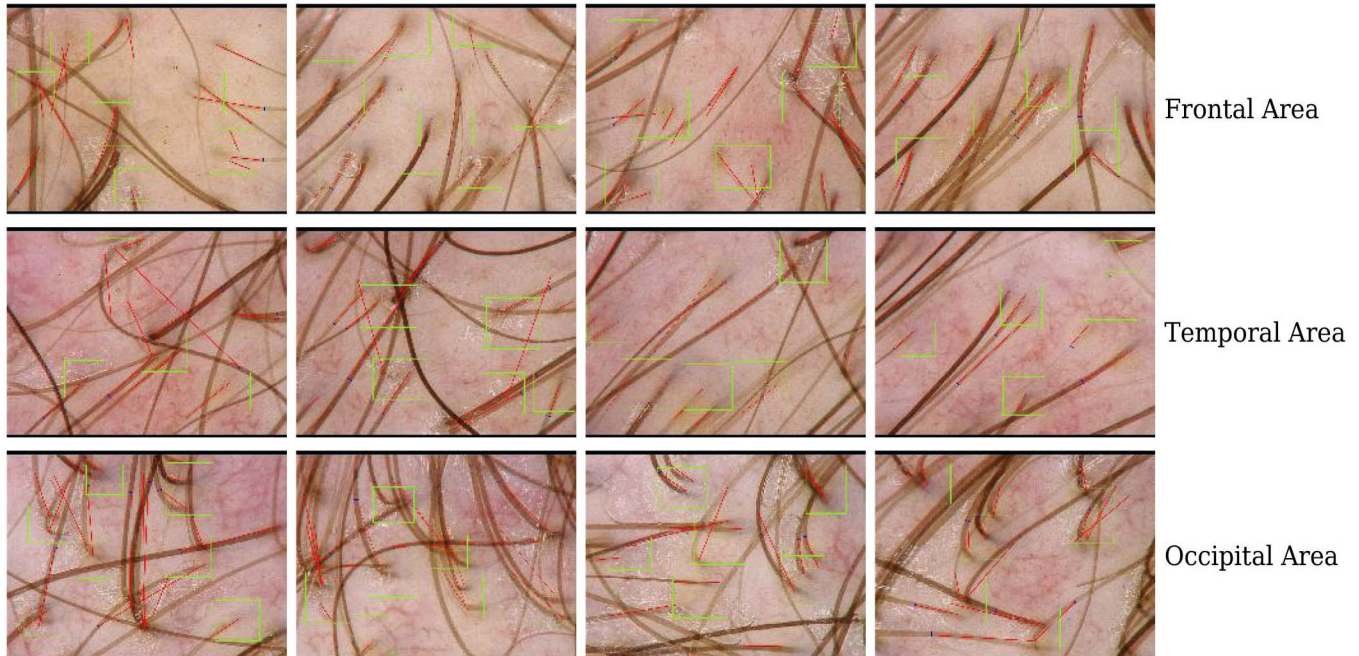

Conclusions:

Features of early androgenetic alopecia: increased number of empty hair follicles and increased number of single-hair units in the frontal area, average hair shaft thickness in the frontal area lower than average hair shaft thickness in the occipital area. Marked hair diameter diversity in the frontal area.
